# *The Annual* ARCHON WEEKEND



On October 7–9, 2022, the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle held its annual Archon Weekend at the New York Hilton Midtown. The weekend recognized many individuals who were worthy of their efforts in securing religious freedom for the Ecumenical Patriarchate.

## The Athenagoras Human Rights Award

His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America, Exarch of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, together with Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, presented the Athenagoras Human Rights Award to His Beatitude Theodore II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, during the annual Athenagoras Human Rights Award Banquet held at the New York Hilton Hotel on October 8, 2022, with over 600 Archons and guests in attendance.

In a message commemorating the occasion, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew stated: "It is worthy and right that the Order of St. Andrew is bestowing the Athenagoras Human Rights Award of 2022 to His Beatitude Theodore, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, in honor of his great contribution to the Church and humankind, as well as his labors in support of the right to religious freedom in Africa, the great continent to which, as His Beatitude our brother says, 'belongs the future.'"

His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros stated: "His Beatitude Theodore II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, has manifested the very qualities of his Saintly predecessor, the Holy Evangelist Mark. For he has been lion-like in his defense of those who would not only invade and attack his pious flock, but who would disrupt the order of the Church with their innovations." In his statement upon conferring the award, His Eminence compared His Beatitude to another one of his predecessors in the See of Alexandria, Saint Athanasios the Great, who endured


persecution and exile for his defense of the Orthodox Faith. "Our Patriarch Theodoros knows this same persecution," said His Eminence, "which has been relentless because of His stand for the good canonical order of the Church – supporting the Ecumenical Patriarchate's decision to grant Autocephaly to the Orthodox Church of Ukraine, and thus, to restore millions of Ukrainians to the Canonical Church."

His Eminence added: "I think it is safe to say that His Beatitude is an admirer of the Slavic tradition; for he has much experience from his time as the Patriarchal

Exarch in Odessa. He has had warm relationships with the Ukrainian and Russian Churches. But because of His righteous stance, the Moscow Patriarchate – which is supporting full-on aggression and violence against the Ukrainian People, as well as the illegal seizure of Ukrainian lands by sham elections at gunpoint – has uncanonically invaded the Continent of Africa, which is the complete ecclesiastical domain of the Most Holy Patriarchate of Alexandria.”

In his remarks on presenting the Award, National Commander Limberakis paid tribute to His Beatitude Patriarch Theodore and declared: “His Beatitude has consistently stood by His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew in fortifying Orthodox Unity through the plan-


ning and implementation of the Holy and Great Council of Crete. His Beatitude Patriarch Theodore II courageously was the first primate of the 14 Autocephalous Churches to recognize the autocephaly of the Orthodox Church of Ukraine and acknowledged that the 41 million peace-loving citizens of Ukraine deserve their own religious freedom. Today, as Russia invades its sister Orthodox nation Ukraine with the blessings of the Patriarchate of Moscow, His Beatitude and the Patriarchate of Alexandria must counter the non-canonical and sinister invasion of the Moscow Patriarchate into the territory of the Patriarchate of Alexandria in Africa.”

Accepting the Award, His Beatitude Patriarch Theodore stated: “I mentally

accompany Archbishop Iakovos of North and South America of blessed memory, when he participated in the Selma-Alabama march, shaking the hand of Martin Luther King during the ‘Bloody Sunday’ of 1965. This event did not only become a cover of ‘Life’ magazine, but won forever a place in the heart of every anti-racist and progressive person of his time, here in the American continent, which rightfully boasts of democratic and liberal practices, respects the personality of the other, capitalizes on people’s skills, appreciates possibilities and cultivates chances to benefit the other regardless of religious, racial, social, educational origins and differences. Archbishop Iakovos did not implement a religious type of activism, but gave meaning to

his pastorate here with actions full of humanity, understanding, protest in favor of oppressed African-Americans and by extension all those who are deprived of the basics due to their external or internal differences.”

His Beatitude added: “Man throughout history has several times felt that he is a weak, lonely, defenseless being. In order for there to be any form of freedom, rivers of blood were shed, there were conflicts upon conflicts, individuals and peoples fought. The result was not always what was expected. The fact that there are still places around the world where personal or collective rights are violated shows that we have not yet reached the ideal. More efforts are needed toward this end. Recognizing, conceding, exploiting, respecting the rights - especially of the weak – shows love and offers tranquility. Let us hope that our humble words just heard will provoke reflection, suspend fear and banish pain. Please pray that it will be accomplished as soon as possible as I will humbly continue to pray and actually strive hard for it.”

During the Athenagoras Award Gala, \$350,000 was raised for the mission activity of the Patriarchate of Alexandria. The Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle gave \$100,000, and in a most generous donation of support, Archon John Catsimatidis and the newly elected Archon Tom Makkos each gave \$100,000. \$50,000 was also donated by an Archon who prefers to remain anonymous. The Order has established a way for additional donations to be made to the missionary work of the

Patriarchate of Alexandria.

For his part, His Beatitude Patriarch Theodore honored His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros and Archon Commander Limberakis by designating them members of the Order of Saint Sabbas the Sanctified, an honor that is conferred by the Patriarchate of Alexandria upon those who have engaged in selfless and tireless service to our excessively needy Orthodox brethren in Africa.

The Award was presented to Archon Psaros on Friday, October 7, 2022, in the presence of His Beatitude Theodore II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, by His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America and Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander, at the Bouras Award Dinner at the New York Hilton Hotel.

In a special message commending the selection and congratulating Archon Psaros, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew stated: "Through his faith, devotion, and dedication to the Mother Church, Archon Michael has shown himself to be the exemplification of the very best in filial piety, a pietas worthy of Aeneas himself. His many benefactions to the Ecumenical Patriarchate, to the Order of Saint Andrew, to the Holy Archdiocese of America, and to the Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church and National Shrine, all manifest a deep love and commitment that exceeds even his extraordinary success in industry. ## Archon Dr. Nawaf and Rim Salameh and Archon Boris and Youlianna Gurov Receive Archon Sophia Award for Excellence

On October 8, 2022, at the Annual Archon Agape Luncheon, the Order of St. Andrew, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, presented the Archon Sophia Award for Excellence to Archon Dr. Nawaf and Rim Salameh and Archon Boris and Youlianna Gurov.

Dr. Maria A. Limberakis, the beloved wife of Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander of the Order, presided over the luncheon and offered commentary on the role of an Archon from a family perspective: The 2022 Religious Freedom Mission and the Role of the Archon Family. Dr. Maria Limberakis stated that “Archon-elect Nawaf and Rim Daoud Salameh from Romania and Archon Boris and Yulianna Gurov from Bulgaria exemplify what it means to live a life in service. They are staunch supporters of the Mother Church and our Orthodox Faith in Romania, Bulgaria, and throughout Europe, in regions where the Moscow Patriarchate has tried to undermine the canonical prerogatives of the Ecumenical Patriarchate and destroy Orthodox Christian unity. They have stood firm and supported the Orthodox Church in their respective countries, as well as their brothers and sisters in Ukraine who are victims of an illegal and unjust war, which has been blessed by the Patriarch Kirill of Moscow. On a recent religious freedom mission to Bulgaria and Romania, they embraced our delegation as family. They arranged meetings with the highest level of civil



and ecclesiastical authorities, individuals who can further the Archons’ mission of religious freedom.”

Dr. Maria Limberakis then invited to the podium Nicholas S. Kass, Executive Director for International Corporate Affairs for the Alexandria Group and former Deputy Assistant Secretary in the Bureau of Conflict and Stabilization Operations at the U.S. Department of State, and former Director for European Affairs and Director of Intelligence Programs at the White House/National Security Council. Kass stated: “The Salamehs and the Gurovs are being honored today in part for the indispensable service rendered to the Archons, and to the Ecumenical Patriarchate itself, in facilitating a delegation of Archon leaders accompanied by Father Alex [Karloutsos] to Romania and Bulgaria (and Greece). During the visit, the Archon group met with Orthodox leaders, secular officials, and the senior-most American diplomats in these countries. As a former diplo-

mat, I can attest to the ground-breaking nature of this trip, coming as it did at a time of war between the West and Russia in Ukraine.”

Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, remarked: “Archons Gurov and Salameh and their beloved wives were essential to the success of our Archon Religious Freedom Mission to Romania and Bulgaria, as well as Greece. The service they rendered to the cause of our Holy Mother Church, and to the protection of religious freedom, cannot be understated. It is for that and so much more that they richly deserve the Sophia Award.”

The Sophia Award for Excellence is given annually by the Order to an individual or individuals who have distinguished themselves in endeavors that serve the needs of the Holy Mother Church and the Sacred Mission of the Archons of the Great Church of Christ.

## Archons Attend Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE), Meet with U.S. Delegation

On September 25–29, 2022, Archons Franklin (Rocky) Sisson, Jr., Archon Prepositos, and Archon Hon. Steven G. Counelis, Archon Nomophylax, participated in the annual Warsaw Human Dimension Conference of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) in Warsaw, Poland, where they made poignant presentations promoting the religious freedom of the Holy Mother Church. The Archon two-man team met with delegations from the United States and other countries and entities dedicated to human rights and fundamental freedoms worldwide.

The OSCE's annual Warsaw Human Dimension Conference is Europe's largest annual human rights and democracy conference. It is a platform for the 57 OSCE participating nation states, international organizations and other relevant actors to take stock of the implementa-

tion of the OSCE's human dimension commitments.

Since 2006, the Order has sent a delegation to the OSCE meetings in order to present vital information to the international community on the Turkish Republic's continuing violations of human rights and religious freedom perpetrated against the Ecumenical Patriarchate.

Archons Sisson and Counelis each participated in the assembly and submitted written statements. On September 28, Archon Sisson presented an oral argument detailing the discrimination and impediments to religious freedom faced by the Ecumenical Patriarchate in Turkey today.

Many of the 57 participating nation states send ambassadors to the OSCE. Because of the conference's immense importance and prestige, the U.S. State Department sends a delegation to the meetings as well. Archons Sisson and

“ [The Ecumenical Patriarchate] for many years has faced a hostile environment which at times has threatened its very existence. This is why in 2022, Turkey continues to be on the ‘special watch list’ of the United States Commission on International Religious Freedom as it has been since 2013. According to the 2022 Report, ‘the state of religious freedom in Turkey remained deeply troubling, with the perpetuation of restrictive and intrusive governmental policies on religious practice and a marked increase in incidents of vandalism and societal violence against religious minorities.’” –Archon Sisson



Counelis conferred with the United States representatives, including the United States Ambassador to the OSCE, Michael R. Carpenter, and head of the American delegation Ambassador Michael G. Kozak of the U.S. State Department. The Archons provided these officials with the most current information regarding the status of our Ecumenical Patriarchate in Turkey, and regarding the major issues, most recent developments and current documents of the Order.

Archons Counelis and Sisson also conferred with others in attendance who are sympathetic to the plight of the Ecumenical Patriarchate.

Anthony J. Limberakis, M.D., National Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, stated: "Since

2006 The Order has prioritized sending a delegation to the OSCE Human Dimension meetings so that the ongoing, egregious violations of fundamental religious freedom and institutional human rights are presented to the world community. I salute this year's delegation of Archons Rocky Sisson and Judge Steve Counelis who left family and homes to serve the needs of the Great Church of Christ in Warsaw, Poland. Along with Archons Sisson and Counelis, in previous years Archons Dr. Spiro Macris, Dr. Nicholas G. Loutsion, Theofanis V. Economidis, Constantine G. Caras, Esq. and Dr. Stamatis Kartalopoulos have made impactful presentations fighting for religious freedom for our Holy Mother Church in the OSCE arena."



Archons met with Oleksiy Goncharenko, a member of the Ukrainian Parliament, during OSCE conference. Goncharenko made a presentation at a reception that included Civil Society members, as well as the U.S. delegation at the OSCE conference, including Dr. Michael Carpenter, above. During his presentation, Goncharenko displayed a Ukrainian flag that flew over Kyiv during the recent battles for the city. Bullet holes were clearly visible in the flag.

“ The presentation was a very moving moment. Oleksiy Goncharenko left his country that same morning as Iranian drones were dropping bombs, and flew to Warsaw with a bullet-ridden Ukrainian flag. When he displayed that flag to those who were assembled at the U.S. Ambassador’s reception, all in attendance were visibly moved. It was a powerful moment of international diplomacy.” –Archon Counelis

# TRAGIC FIRE RAVAGES BALIKLI GREEK HOSPITAL

## Archons Donate \$100,000 for Relief and Rebuilding

At noon on Thursday, August 4, 2022, the courageous remnant of Greek Orthodox Christians in Constantinople was deeply shaken by a tragic fire at the Balikli Greek Hospital and Home for the Aged in the Zeytinburnu district of the city. The fire caused immense structural damage. However, the loss of life was prevented with the support of state and local institutions, surrounding hospitals, neighbors and the staff of the institution. The National Council of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, voted unanimously to approve a \$100,000 donation for the relief of those who have been displaced by this fire, and for the rebuilding of the structure.

Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, stated: "Above all, we thank God that no one was killed. Unfortunately, however, the devastation that this fire has caused is quite extensive. Balikli Greek Hospital is a jewel of the Orthodox community in Constantinople; it is housed in one of Constantinople's celebrated historic buildings. The Greek

Hospital in Balikli was founded in 1753, and performs the all-important service of caring for the elderly Greek Orthodox Christians of the city. It is the mission of the Archons to support and defend our Holy Mother Church, and we are grateful to God that we are able to make this donation."

Just two days before this catastrophic fire, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew presided over the Holy Service of the Canon of Supplication to the Most Holy Theotokos at the Church

of Saints Anargyroi of the Balikli Nursing Home.

In his speech immediately afterwards, His All-Holiness called it a great injustice that religious minorities in Turkey have not been allowed to renew the administration of their institutions for so many years, "during which many died, many left, and many of our institutions, our churches, could not be administered and function properly, with the risk that representatives would be appointed by the State and that the administration




of these institutions would be removed from the members of the community, to which they belong.”

His All-Holiness then expressed his disappointment because the minority-owned hospitals were excluded from the process. “We are being told that for these particular institutions we will be allowed to conduct elections next year. This saddens us, and we do not hesitate to say that to all directions, because our hospital, now I am only talking about our minority, which is the largest of our institutions, is an integral part of our Community, our traditions, our heritage, and when they exclude it from the rest of the Community, the authorities are being unjust to that institution and to the Community as a whole.”

Dr. Limberakis noted: “Now this integral part of the Greek Community in Constantinople has suffered extensive damage. We ask for prayers for all those who currently reside in the Balikli Nursing Home or who are being treated at the Balikli Greek Hospital, that they would find appropriate care and lodging. We further pray that the entire Oikoumene would see their brothers and sisters in need and come to their aid now by donating to the Balikli Hospital and Home for the Aged Fire Devastation Relief Fund, for their need is urgent.”

His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America stated: “I am so very happy for Father Alex, Presvytera Xanthi, and their children and grandchildren. This is such an exceptional distinction that it practically leaves me speechless. That a son of the Church, the son of a priest, born in Greece and humbly serving His Church for over fifty years is to be recognized by the highest civilian honor of the United States, is a moment in which every Greek Orthodox and every

Greek American should take tremendous pride, especially in this week when we celebrate the Centennial of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America. This is a unique honor for Father Alex, whose decades of ministry in our Archdiocese and the Ecumenical Patriarchate cannot be summed up with any amount of words. Rather, I know that we all send him our warmest and most heartfelt congratulations, with our acknowledgment of this profound recognition by the President of the United States. Αἰῶσι!”

“As a brother PK (priest’s kid),” said Dr. Anthony J. Limberakis, National Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle, Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, “I take special pride in the bestowal of this honor upon Father Alex, and am delighted that he is now receiving national and international recognition for his tireless labor for God and His Church. # 'Orthopaedic Legend' and Archon Par Excellence Dr. Michael J. Patzakis Honored at The Ohio State University



The Archon Engagement Committees are an initiative that was organized by Archon Stephen A. Georgeson, Esq.






## Patriarchal Green Initiatives Committee






### Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew Foundation




## Metropolis and Parish Education Committee



**Archons welcome Archbishop Elpidophoros to Pacific Northwest**


