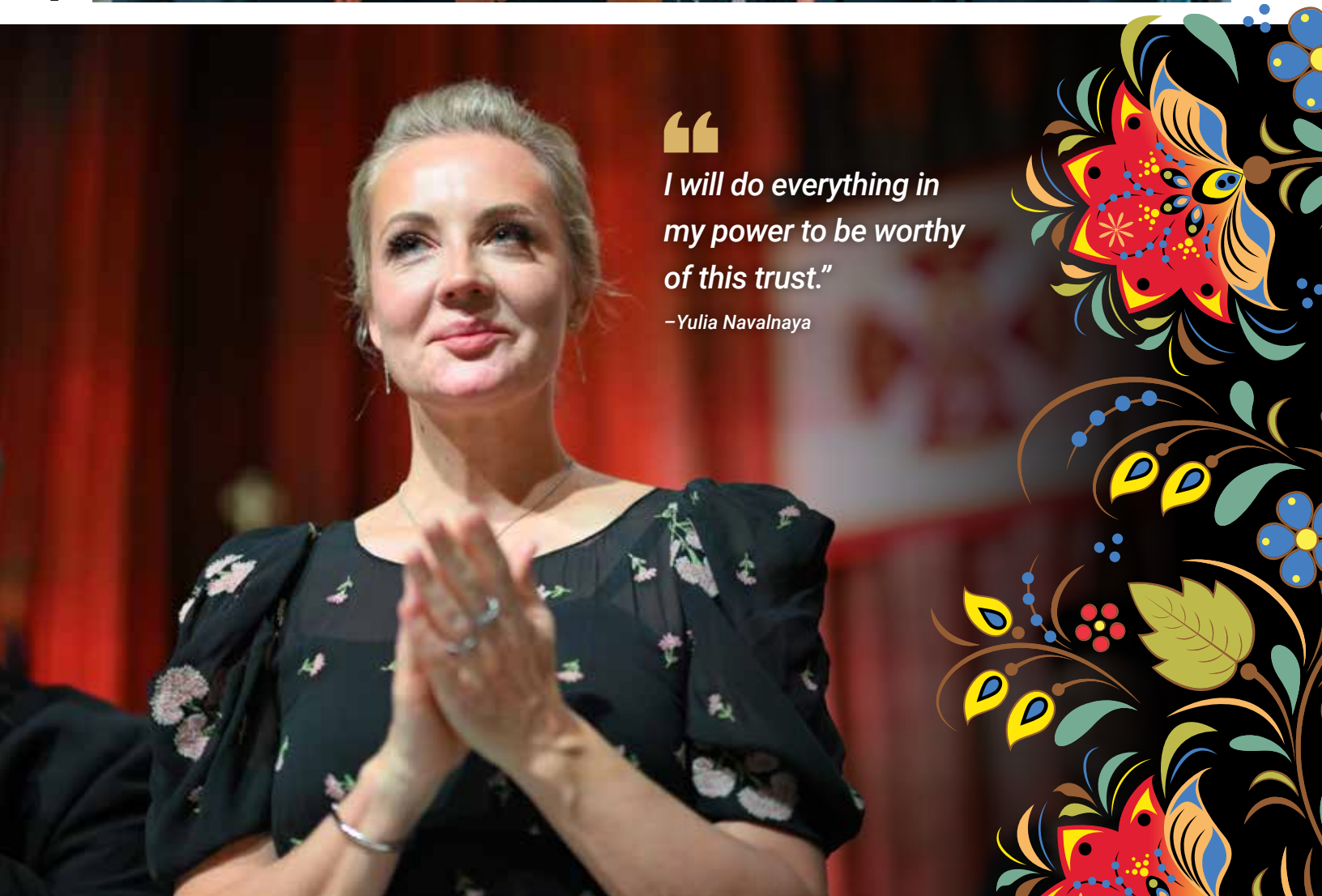

In his Archepiscopal Acclamation, His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros declared: "This evening is an auspicious and blessed event, for it calls to mind the memory of a great man, and we remember him by honoring a man with a similar dedication to service. He explained that Archon Skeadas' offikion, Hieromnimon, which

was chosen for him by His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew himself, was highly significant. Hiero, His Eminence explained, essentially means "one who is consecrated." This was fitting, he said, addressing Archon Peter, as "you take very seriously your role in the Church." His Eminence added that

mnimon, meanwhile, means "one who holds the memory, a spiritual archivist, if you will." He stated that no corner of the Church has not been touched by Archon Peter's service and wisdom. "You are a leader," His Eminence concluded. "You are most worthy to receive the Nicholas J. Bouras Award."

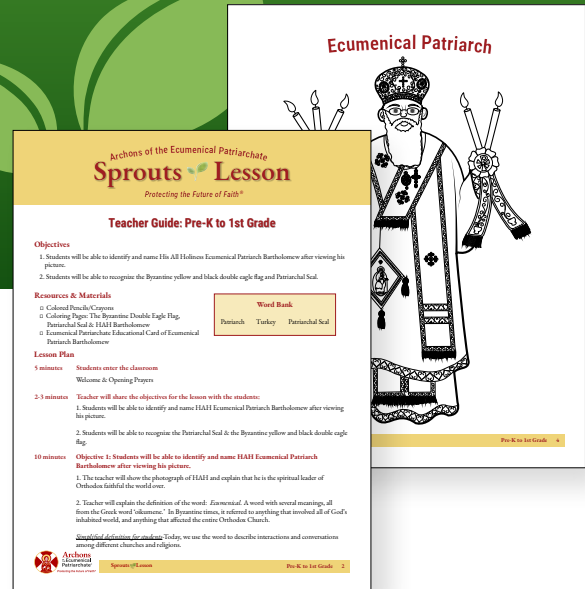

Archon James G. Rockas has been appointed to serve as Deputy Undersecretary of Commerce for Industry and Security in the Trump Administration. In this capacity, Archon Rockas will lead the Bureau of Industry and Security's mission to advance U.S. national security, foreign policy, and economic growth.

Dr. Limberakis stated: "The appointment of Archon James G. Rockas to this key position illustrates anew how each Archon serves God, His Holy Church, our Holy Mother Church of Constantinople, and His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew in a huge variety of arenas, bringing the timeless sacred values of the Church into the secular realm."



Reception and Dinner in Honor of His Beatitude Metropolitan Epiphaniy of Kyiv and All Ukraine Primate of the Orthodox Church of Ukraine



In the presence of His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America, the Archons hosted a reception and dinner on February 10, 2025 in honor of His Beatitude Metropolitan Epiphaniy of Kyiv and All Ukraine, recipient of the 2019 Athenagoras Human Rights Award. This event, a key element of His Beatitude's Archpastoral Visit to the United States, was a notable tribute to the courage, tenacity, perseverance, and above all the faith of His Beatitude and the Ukrainian people.



An Historical Overview

Dr. Limberakis, above left, explained that the history of Christianity in Ukraine began when the Ecumenical Patriarchate sent Saints Cyril and Methodios to Kyiv. Thus the Holy Faith was given by Constantinople to Kyiv, and by Kyiv to Moscow; hence history contradicted Moscow's treatment of Kyiv and Ukraine as a constituent part of Russia. He also noted that Moscow, in its quest to supplant Constantinople and become the "Third Rome," had appropriated the double-headed eagle symbol of the Ecumenical Patriarchate. He pointed out that the AEP used the symbol as a visible manifestation of its mission to support and defend the Ecumenical Patriarchate, while Moscow's appropriation of it was a masquerade that was intended to delegitimize Constantinople and arrogate to itself its Ecumenical status within the Orthodox Church. Dr. Limberakis stated: "Ever since the passing of Archon John Halecky Jr., the Carpatho-Russian Archons have not participated in the AEP leadership, and that void will now be filled by a most able and committed Archon of the Holy and Great Church of Christ. Axios, Archon Gary!"

Gary Grysiak was invested as an Archon on February 27, 1999 and conferred with the offikion Aktouarios.



AEP Establishes New Archon Engagement Committee: Archon Medical And Dental Missionary Work, Chaired by Archon Thomas P. Williams, DDS, MD, FACS

The Archons has established a new Archon Engagement Committee: The Archon Medical and Dental Missionary Work Engagement Committee. This much-needed new committee is designed to facilitate the providing of basic medical and dental care to indigent children in Orthodox countries.

Dr. Limberakis, in appointing Archon Thomas P. Williams, DDS, MD, FACS as Chair of this new Committee, explained, "the Bylaws of Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate state that a key part of the mission of the Archons is to 'provide for and contribute towards the general welfare of the poor, handicapped and disadvantaged.' That's what this new Archon Engagement Committee, The Archon Medical and Dental Missionary Work, is dedicated to doing."

The Archon Medical and Dental Missionary Work Engagement Committee will be focused upon providing basic medical and dental care to indigent children in Orthodox countries such as Greece, Albania, Bulgaria, and Romania, as well as possibly in Turkey also, wherever there may be need. Diligent care will be taken in determination of need, and the medical care itself will be provided by a mission team of volunteer, self-funded Archon medical specialists, dentists and nurses.

Archon Williams was invested as an Archon on October 9, 2022 and conferred with the offikion Orphanotrofos.



Archbishop Elpidophoros Tabs Archon Theo Nicolakis to be Director of National Ministries for the Archdiocese of America

In yet another manifestation of the profound commitment of the Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate to diakonia, His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros has chosen Archon Theo Nicolakis to be his new Director of National Ministries for the Holy Archdiocese of America.

This position has been vacant for a quarter of a century. But in God's Holy Church today, where there is a need, there is an Archon. The appointment of Archon Theo to this position demonstrates the relentless dedication of the AEP to fulfilling our mission of supporting and defending our Ecumenical Patriarchate and the Church worldwide: when the Church calls, Archons are ready to answer.

Archon Nicolakis is a graduate of Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology. He was invested as Archon in 2011 and conferred with the offikion Kastrinsios.



Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew Offers Wisdom And Guidance On Artificial Intelligence (AI)

As artificial intelligence (AI) becomes an ever more common feature of our daily lives, the imperative to prevent abuse of it grows increasingly urgent. In several recent public addresses, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew has spoken about the ethical issues surrounding AI, providing much-needed wisdom on this new and still largely unexplored field of human endeavor.

His All-Holiness recently formally inaugurated the 4th International Ecological Well-Being Conference, “Artificial Intelligence, Technoethics, and Youth,” at the Marasleio School in Athens. In his address, he reminded those attending the conference that “the Orthodox tradition is an inexhaustible source of vital principles and truths for humanity and the world.”^[1]

His All-Holiness further explained: “Naturally, the remarkable theological texts do not contain ready-made answers to address contemporary problems. Instead, they require study and serious theological effort to articulate the proposal of life, freedom, and the universal values of Orthodoxy. For this reason, we are pleased to see theology engaging with the topic of ‘artificial intelligence.’”

The Ecumenical Patriarch also spoke about the conflict that some see between faith and science, and emphasized that new scientific innovations had to be used in an ethical manner. “In light of the remarkable advancements in science and technology,” he said, “we affirm our conviction that these achievements, when used responsibly and ethically, can contribute to genuine progress without compromising fundamental moral and spiritual principles and values. We do not regard the conflict between faith and science as inevitable.”

Regarding artificial intelligence, His All-Holiness reminded those in attendance that “your conference – our conference – also focuses on young people, whose lives will inevitably unfold within the environment shaped by the dynamic integration of artificial intelligence into our daily existence.” He added:

Obviously, the new generation is neither technophobic nor indifferent to new technologies, as these are integral to the core of their lives. The Church, while advocating for the responsible use of artificial intelligence, encourages young people to cultivate “spiritual intelligence” by explor-

ing and embracing the invaluable spiritual and cultural treasures of our Orthodox Tradition. This aligns with the invitation extended to them by the Council of Crete in its Message: “The Orthodox Church addresses young people, who seek a life of fullness enriched by freedom, justice, creativity, and love.”

It invites them to consciously connect with the Church of Christ, who is the Truth and Life, and to actively engage with the ecclesiastical body, bringing their energy, concerns, aspirations, and expectations. Young people are not merely the future of the Church; they are its dynamic and creative presence, both locally and globally” (§ 11).

Then in his address to the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe in Strasbourg, France, Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew again emphasized the imperative of maintaining respect for ethical boundaries when using AI.^[2]

“Looking at the Framework Convention on Artificial Intelligence of the Council of Europe,” His All-Holiness stated, “the Ecumenical Patriarchate observes notable progress in addressing crucial ethical and social concerns raised by this fast-growing technology.” He underlined the fact

that “artificial intelligence has immense potential for positive transformation in environmental protection, education, and healthcare, offering innovative pathways to solve significant human problems. At the same time, from invasions of privacy to rising inequalities and possible compromise of institutions, this great tool also contains inherent risks.”

Accordingly, His All-Holiness declared that “implementation of artificial intelligence requires respect of individual dignity, safeguard of fundamental freedoms, and advancement of social equity.” He added that “in this context, the Orthodox Christian tradition would underline moral discernment and direction along with scientific research and development.” He said that “the Ecumenical Patriarchate invites all nations to participate in this important project for the sake of supporting and shaping a technological growth that satisfies the universal needs of humankind, including the protection of human rights and religious freedom for those facing persecution and injustice, particularly religious minorities who have historically endured discrimination.”

The Ecumenical Patriarch also noted that the stakes were extremely high. “We can make a difference in the world,” he concluded. “We can bring greater healing to its people. We can provide renewed hope if all of us—political and religious leaders—work together toward a shared goal: namely, to leave behind a better world for our children than what we inherited or created. A world where conflict and war are not the ways of resolving disputes and divisions; where all religions and all races are equally and indiscriminately respected; where people have enough love as the mother tongue of all humankind; and where nature’s diversity is protected.”

Were the innovators of AI technology to bear these eternal truths constantly in mind, the risks of AI would be substantially reduced, and indeed, could be eradicated altogether.

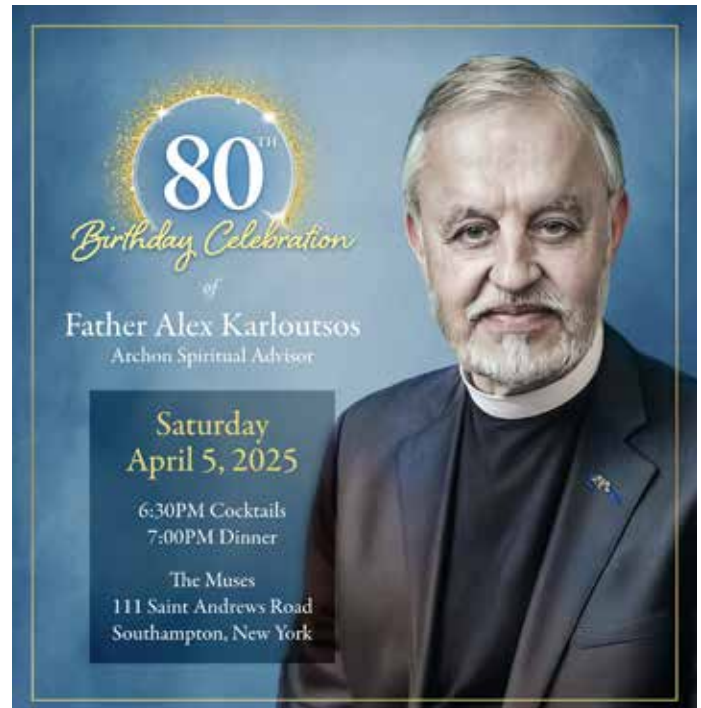
